**EA Education Requirement:** 72 hours education per enrollment period (3 years) which consist of a minimum of 16 hours education annually and a minimum of 2 hours ethics courses annually.

**CRTP Education Requirement:** 20 hours education annually which consist of 15 hours IRS approved education (10 hours federal tax law, 3 hours federal tax law update, 2 hours ethics) AND an additional 5 hours California tax law.

AFSP Education Requirement: 18 Hours education annually which consists of a 6 Hour Annual Federal Tax Refresher (AFTR) Course & Test, 10 Hours Federal Tax Law and 2 Hours Ethics. Preparers currently registered with CTEC (California), OBTP (Oregon) and MSBITP (Maryland) are exempt from the AFSP requirements

# LAST CHANCE TO RENEW YOUR CTEC WITHOUT RETAKING THE 60-HOUR COURSE

A California Registered Tax Preparer (CRTP) must annually renew their registration with the California Tax Education Council (CTEC) each year before October 31st.

We've been reminding you to renew your CRTP license for the past two months. "If you fail to renew your CTEC registration by January 15, (CTEC) will consider you a new tax preparer and subject to the new preparer registration requirements." (which means you'll be required to take the 60-Hour CTEC Qualifying Course again)

"New Video Training Course Makes It Easier To Become (an Unpaid) Tax Prep Volunteer

Sacramento – The Franchise Tax Board (FTB) today released a new, free video training course aimed at helping volunteers become IRS-certified to prepare income tax returns during tax season.

The 11-part course, taught by FTB's Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) trainers and spanning just under two hours total, is available at FTB's website, ftb.ca.gov.

VITA volunteers spend the fall and early winter training for tax season. Volunteers then give their time to prepare returns for low- to moderate-income families for free in communities around the state.

"Now from your own home you can learn to prepare tax returns and help members of your community in a meaningful way," State Controller and FTB Chair Betty T. Yee said.

The new video course covers what volunteers need to know about federal and state income tax returns, including changes brought about by recent federal tax reform.

In-person VITA training is also available around the state. To find a location near you, visit:

VITA is administered by the IRS and supported by FTB. The program is an important way for families to get their federal and state tax returns done for free, allowing them to receive

any refund they are due and in some cases connect with the cash-back California Earned Income Tax Credit (CalEITC)"
